Special congratulations to Sadie G, Thisanya D and Ethan F for gaining the most positive points out of the school this week.

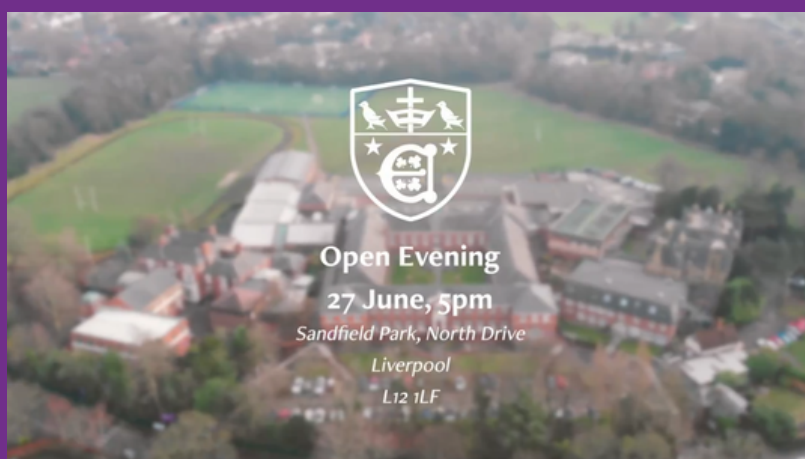
