### All pupils should:

- Wear the correct school uniform that is clean and smart
- Wear full school uniform when travelling to and from school
- Provide a note of explanation from parents if the correct school uniform is not worn to school

<b>Boys</b>	<p><b>College Uniform</b> (Please see extra guidance on the overall appearance of a St Edward's pupil) Trousers must be purchased from the school uniform provider.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shirts must be tucked in and top buttons fastened at all times.</li></ul> <p>Ties must be purchased from the school uniform provider and the knot must cover top button</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Socks - must wear plain grey socks.</li><li>• All clothing must be clearly labelled.</li></ul> <p><b>Shoes</b> (Please see guidance provided on shoes)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• They must be plain in style, safe, sensible and fit for purpose.</li><li>• They must be flat soled and made of plain, black, polishable or patent leather.</li></ul> <p><b>ID / Lanyard and Badges</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ID must be worn at all times</li><li>• Badges allowed on lapel of blazer - House, College Council, Prefect, College Colours and other approved College activities</li><li>• Pupils can wear the Marie Curie Daffodil or the Poppy as they are charities supported by the College.</li><li>• Pupils can put all other badges on bags and pencil cases</li></ul> <p><b>Appearance:</b></p> <p><b>Hair</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Should be neat and tidy at all times.</li><li>• Should be cut in a conventional style, clear of the collar, eyes and ears.</li><li>• No hair gel</li><li>• Boys must be clean shaven.</li></ul> <p><b>Jewellery</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It is not permitted to wear jewellery</li></ul> <p><b>School bags</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must be of a plain colour and should be fit for purpose.</li></ul>
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<b>Girls</b>	<p><b>College Uniform</b> (Please see extra guidance on the overall appearance of a St Edward's pupil)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skirt must be knee length and worn on the waist, not on the hips and be purchased from the school uniform provider.</li> <li>• Shirts must be tucked in and top buttons fastened at all times.</li> <li>• Ties must be purchased from the school uniform provider and the knot must cover top button.</li> <li>• Socks/Tights:</li> <li>• Years 7 to 9, girls must wear white ankle socks or plain grey tights.</li> <li>• Years 10 and 11, girls must wear white ankle socks or plain black tights.</li> <li>• All clothing must be clearly labelled.</li> </ul> <p><b>Shoes</b> (Please see guidance provided on shoes)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be plain in style, safe, sensible and fit for purpose.</li> <li>• They must be flat soled and made of plain, black, polishable or patent leather.</li> <li>• Trainers are not allowed.</li> <li>• Shoes with ankle straps, decorative adornments or heels are not permitted.</li> </ul> <p><b>ID / Lanyard and Badges</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ID and Lanyard to be worn at all times.</li> <li>• Badges allowed on lapel of blazer - House, College Council, Prefect, School Colours or Academic Award (DoE)</li> <li>• Pupils can wear the Marie Curie Daffodil or the Poppy as they are charities supported by the College.</li> <li>• Pupils can put all other badges on bags and pencil cases</li> </ul> <p><b>Appearance:</b></p> <p><b>Hair</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Should be neat and tidy at all times.</li> <li>• It must not be dyed or highlighted and hair extensions are not permitted.</li> <li>• It should be tied back in a simple, plain black or purple bobble, ribbon or hair band. No other style of hair accessory or adornment will be tolerated.</li> </ul> <p><b>Make up</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is not permitted (including nail varnish, false eye lashes and false tan)</li> </ul> <p><b>Jewellery</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is not permitted</li> <li>• Ear piercing must take place during school holidays to allow adequate time for healing.</li> <li>• Plasters may not be used to cover earrings.</li> </ul> <p><b>School Bags</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be of a plain colour and should be fit for purpose.</li> </ul>
