# **Boys** | College Uniform

- They must be flat soled and made of plain, black, polishable or patent leather.

- ID must be worn at all times

- Pupils can put all other badges on bags and pencil cases

# Girls College Uniform (Please see extra guidance on the overall appearance of a

- Trainers are not allowed.
- Shoes with ankle straps, decorative adornments or heels are not permitted.

## Hair

- Should be neat and tidy at all times.
