**Dear Parent/Carer,**

**Mock Examinations - (REF 013/25)**

We are writing to inform you that the Year 11 mock examinations will take place from Monday, 3 March to Wednesday, 12 March. The full timetable for these examinations is attached for your reference.

We are continuing with our school-wide revision programme for Year 11 in preparation for the forthcoming mock examinations. Each pupil has been provided with a detailed outline of the content to be assessed in their subjects, along with the duration of each exam.

As part of the revision initiative, each GCSE subject has set work on a variety of online platforms such as Seneca, Dr Frost, and others. These resources are tailored to the mock exam content and complement regular homework. By completing all tasks across the seven subjects, pupils will have covered the entire syllabus in preparation for their examinations. This is attached for your reference.

In addition to this, we are offering after-school revision sessions for pupils to attend on set days:

- **Monday:** Science and Computer science
- **Tuesday:** English
- **Wednesday:** History, Spanish, and French
- **Thursday:** Geography and Design Technology
- **Friday:** Mathematics

Some of these sessions are **open to all** pupils, while others are **invitation only**. The **invitation-only sessions** are designed for pupils who may need extra support in specific areas based on their recent performance or teacher assessments. These pupils will be contacted directly and encouraged to attend these targeted sessions. For the **open sessions**, all pupils are welcome to attend and benefit from additional support to strengthen their revision.

We encourage all pupils to attend these after-school sessions to further enhance their preparation for the mock examinations.

We also encourage you to follow our social media platforms, where we will be celebrating the hard work and dedication of our pupils throughout this revision period.

By following this structured revision plan, we hope that your child will feel well-prepared and confident entering their mock examinations, leading to positive results.

During the mock exam period, pupils will be allowed to leave the school site at 1:25 pm each day. This adjustment is intended to support their wellbeing and give them time at home to revise for the next day's examinations.
